





Jainism is a religion that prescribes a path of non-violence towards all living beings.

Tradition says that this belief has been preached by a succession of twenty-four propagators of faith known as tirthankara. Jainism emphasises spiritual independence and equality between all forms of life. Practitioners of this religion believe that non-violence and self-control is the means by which they can obtain liberation from the cycle of reincarnations.





Judaism is a religion originating in the Hebrew Bible; it is considered to be the expression of the covenantal relationship God established with the Children of Israel. God revealed his laws and commandments to Moses on Mount Sinai in the form of both the Written and Oral Torah.

Sikhism is a religion founded in the Punjab region in India by Guru Nanak Dev and continued to progress with ten successive Sikh gurus. God termed Vâhigurû is shapeless, timeless, and sightless: nirakâr, akaal, and alakh. Sikh teaching emphasizes the principle of equality of all humans and rejects discrimination on the basis of caste, creed and gender. God is omnipresent and infinite with power over everything.





Zoroastrianism is a religion based on the teachings of Prophet Zoroaster. There is one universal and transcendent God, Ahura Mazda. The Creator Ahura Mazda is all good, and no evil originates from him. Water and fire are agents of ritual purity.
